
I am directed to refer to this Ministry's communication F.No.35-10/2013-TS.III dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 (copy enclosed) vide which the CIWG reservation and its fee structure was communicated under para 2 (1) of the above referred communication.

2. The matter of tuition fee structure for the students belonging to Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf (CIWG) category has been reviewed in the Ministry. The competent authority has decided that the students belonging to CIWG category and taking admissions in the undergraduate programmes of the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) under the Direct Admission of Students Abroad (DASA) Scheme will pay tuition fee of Rs.1,25,000/- per student per annum either in Indian Rupees (INR) or equivalent US Dollars at existing exchange rate.

3. The DASA coordinating Institution is requested to implement the above mentioned decision for admissions to the academic year 2017 – 2018. The other contents of communication of even number dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 (copy enclosed) remain unchanged.
